




Move-in Weekend Support Tickets

Supporting Student Success – Integrated Educational Technologies

- Supporting the instructional technology in 297 general instructional classrooms and labs
- 213 of the rooms
 within the Classroom
 Technology
 Assistance Program



43% of these classrooms are Hyflex spaces, allowing students to learn in any modality

Supporting Research & Applied Learning

UNCW / NCSU High-Performance Computing Partnership

- Allows UNCW researchers access to 1.5M CPU hours of HPC resources for \$16K/year
- CMS has invested in additional nodes for priority access
- Cost to provide HPC on campus would be in the millions (*Equipment*, power, staff)

Spam and Phishing Attempts


- **7.9 Million** Emails Blocked Automatically (30-day period)
- **291.2 Million** Inbound IP Connections Blocked (93.9M within US; 197.4M outside US)



Microsoft Security Score

- Rated significantly higher than similarly-sized organizations
