



### UNC System Updates



#### Peer List Update

- UNC System requires an update to our official peers list every 5 years.
- Last <u>UNCW update</u> was in 2020.
- Peer Lists are used primarily for benchmarking and comparison purposes. Examples include: official reporting, analysis, (e.g. strategic planning, academic program planning, tuition/fee rates), and more.
- The Process
  - Institutions identify possible peers, then work with System Office to select a list of 10-12 appropriate institutions.
  - Once the UNCW peer list is finalized, Chancellor Volety will inform the Trustees (tentatively late March).
  - Peer lists will go to the Board of Governors for approval, scheduled for later this spring.

## Housing

For the fall 2025 semester we have identified additional bed spaces to help us accommodate Freshmen, Sophomores and 375 new Transfer students:

- Existing on-campus beds 5,200+ beds
- Leased space at off-campus properties 296 beds
  - UNCW will lease 80 beds at the Cottages at College Acres
  - UNCW will take over the entirety of Plato's Lofts at Randall (216 beds)
    - For fall 2024 we leased just 72 beds at Plato's
- In total, we will be able to house well over 5,500 students for fall 2025.


